About The Department

Butler Township a community where rural roots meet modern conveniences. We are home to nearly 8,000 residents and are the ideal place for families to grow and lives to be enriched. Our community has attractive neighborhoods, family-friendly activities, great schools, and a bustling business district.

The Police Department is staffed by 21 full-time sworn officers and a full-time administrative assistant. They are supplemented by one or more part-time or auxiliary officers, one of which serves as the property room manager.

Qualifications

- Current Police Officer Certification by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission
- US Citizen & at least 21 years old
- HS Graduate or GED
- Valid Ohio Driver's License; good driving record
- Eye sight correctable to 20/30
- Possess the physical ability to perform the tasks associated with the position.
- No previous felony convictions
- For lateral entry: 2 years of Full Time Service as a Police Officer from an agency with a similar call load.

Hiring Process

Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will be evaluated through the following phases:

- National Testing Network Exam (entry level candidates)
- Oral Interview(s)
- Background Investigation
- Computer Voice Stress Analysis (CVSA)
- Physical/Medical/Pre-Employment Drug Screen
- Psychological Exam

Benefits

- Salary Range: \$60,527-\$74,401
- Schedule with rotating days off: 8.5hr shifts, 5 on 2 off, 5 on 3 off rotation
- Generous time off package, including:
 - Vacation Leave (2-5 weeks/yr)
 - Sick Leave
 - Wellness Incentive Leave/Pay
 - Compensatory Time Off
 - Personal Absence Days
