Dear Resident,

In March 2022, you received a letter co-authored by Butler Township and Montgomery County Environmental Services concerning per-and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination. We are writing to share developments made toward providing you with **free well water testing**.



In July, the County contracted with Bennett & Williams, Environmental Consultants, Inc. to develop and administer a sampling program to provide you with free testing for your wells. Bennett & Williams will hold two public meetings to communicate the health effects of consuming water contaminated by PFAS and explain how to sign up for free well testing. Those meetings are:

- Sunday, Sep. 11, 2-4 p.m., at Aullwood Audubon Farm, 9101 Frederick Pk, Dayton, 45414
- Thursday, Sep. 22, 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the Butler Township Meeting Hall, located at 3780 Little York Road, Dayton, 45414

You do not need to attend both public meetings as they will cover the same information. Additionally, the meetings are optional, so attendance is not required to qualify for free well testing. Both meetings will be held live via Zoom as well as recorded and posted to Butler Township's website within a week of being held. In-person assistance is available before and after each public meeting and you may also call (614) 581-3436 if you would like help enrolling or have additional questions. **Please note, the last day to sign up for free well testing is October 15, 2022.**

During enrollment, you will be asked several questions to ensure your address is eligible to receive free well testing. Only those residing in the Recommended Well Sampling Area will receive free testing.
